Deanery Event: Martyn's Law at the Door The

Terrorism (Protection of Premises) Act 2025, commonly referred to as Martyn's Law, will improve protective security and organizational preparedness across the UK by requiring that those responsible for certain premises and events consider how they would respond to a terrorist attack and appropriate steps to reduce vulnerability. A session advising churchwardens, sidespeople and welcomers will be held at Croydon Minster on Wednesday 10th September at 7:30pm. For some larger churches, this is going to be a requirement in the wake of the Manchester Arena bombings.

Snippets from the Minutes of February's Deanery Synod

- O The Venerable Carol Ann Coslett was our guest speaker with Dr Michael Brockett. Carol is Assistant Director of Lay Ministry in the Discipleship and Ministry Team, responsible for selection and discernment for Lay Vocations and Ministries as well as teaching those who are training to be Commissioned Pastoral Lay Ministers. Michael is currently the Diocesan Lay Ministry Consultant; a member of the Lay Council and Bishop's Advisory Group for Pastoral Lay Training and Development; a Licensed Pastoral Lay Minister in the South Croydon Benefice (St Peter's & St Augustine's); a Day Chaplain at Southwark Cathedral and Lay Champion for this Deanery. Carol outlined callings of a specifically ministerial dimension which involved being formally Affirmed, Commissioned, or Licensed as a lay minister. Rona Macdonald was licensed as a Reader in October 2024. She described her training journey and current role at St Mildred's.
- O Revd Michael Nayagam and Revd Linda Fox gave us an update on homelessness in Croydon. The Refugee Day Centre operates a drop-in centre for those who have recently been evicted from an asylum hotel having been granted refugee status. The centre is staffed by qualified members of Spires, and in general it is about 5-6 weeks to obtain some form of housing for a refugee. Last winter, there were no night shelters available for single men in South London. They are working hard within the Croydon area (through the auspices of West Croydon Baptist Church who have started this work) to find a way to set up a night shelter for this coming winter.
