More than 50 Christians were arrested by Iran's Ministry of Intelligence in the days following the conflict with Israel in June. They were accused of involvement in "antisecurity" activities and possession of arms. Some of those arrested were detained on returning to Iran after attending a gathering organised in a neighbouring country by a church abroad. Farsi (Persian)-speaking converts from Islam are forbidden from attending Christian worship services in Iran. Pray that the authorities will recognise that Christians pose no threat to national security and that all believers will be released.
